EDUCATION UNDER FIRE: HOW CONFLICT IN THE DRC IS ROBBING CHILDREN OF THEIR FUTURE

_____ (educate) is one of the _____ (found) of a meaningful and _____ (product) adult life. For hundreds of thousands of children in the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC), those hopes are being reduced to rubble.

Conflict has been raging in the DRC for decades. War has claimed thousands of lives, wrecked millions more, and displaced more than 1.3 million. As is so often the case, the _____ (big) victims are the most blameless – the children.

In the last month alone, 119 schools in the North Kivu and Ituri provinces have been attacked, occupied, or temporarily used by _____ (arm) groups. _____ (near) 300 schools cannot operate because they are being used as shelters by people displaced by the conflict. Almost 1,700 schools have been forced to close because they are _____ (simple) not safe to use (in most cases because they are in areas controlled by armed groups).

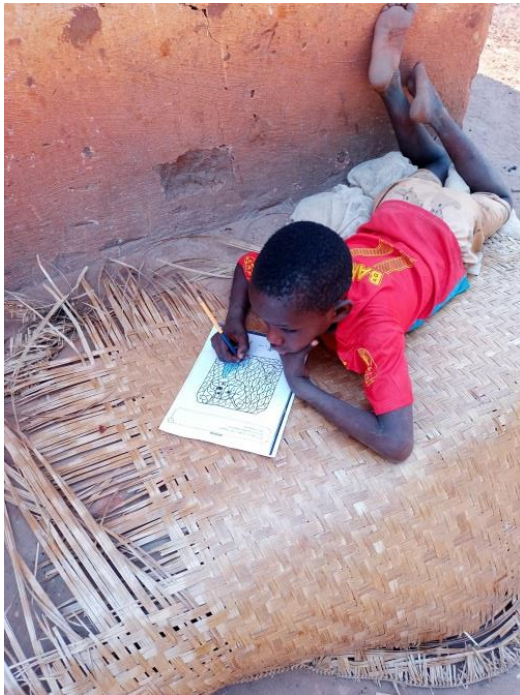
